Camp Hale Rental Guidelines

Camp Hale is a cherished environment primarily dedicated to the 200+ children that attend each summer. While we love to welcome outside groups to the beauty of Squam Lake and the magic of the camp experience, it is imperative that the space remains clean, safe, and beautiful for our children. To ensure the quality of the grounds and facilities is maintained, we respectfully ask all renters to strictly adhere to the following rules:

- **Vehicles:** To prevent erosion and maintain the natural beauty of the grounds, all vehicles may only be driven in designated areas. Designated areas include the road, the upper parking lot, and the lower parking lot. No vehicles are permitted to drive off the road for any reason, including the golf carts which are not permitted to be driven past the lower lot.
- **Furniture and Bunk Beds:** Absolutely no furniture may be disassembled or altered during your stay. This includes detaching beds from walls, de-bunking beds, or removing ladders.
- **Use of Camp Equipment:** All boats and canoes must be removed from the water and properly stored at the end of your stay. All life jackets should be returned to their designated space below the rec hall.
- **Dining Hall and Kitchen:** All dishes and utensils in the dining hall must remain in the dining hall. Please refrain from using dishes as ashtrays as this causes permanent damage. All food and alcohol brought to Camp Hale must be completely removed from the kitchen after your stay. Do not leave food in the fridges, counters, or anywhere else on the premises.
- **Cleaning:** All trash must be removed from the premises by the end of your stay. This includes removing all trash, including used cigarettes, from inside cabins and the outdoor areas. Make sure all floors are swept and left in the same condition they were found in.
- **Smoking:** Smoking of any kind is strictly prohibited inside all buildings on the Camp Hale property. All smoking must occur outdoors, and used cigarettes must be properly disposed of immediately.

Failure to adhere to these rules may result in additional cleaning charges or impact the ability of your group to rent the facility in the future.
