The above-named incorporator(s) do hereby associate (themselves) with the intention of forming a corporation under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 180 and hereby state(s):

1. The name by which the corporation shall be known is:

2. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

As a Corporation organized and to be operated exclusively for charitable purposes, to acquire by gift, devise or otherwise money and property of every kind, nature and description, and to administer and use the same and any income or proceeds thereof solely for such charitable purposes, and more particularly to preserve and protect Camp Hale as a place where young people may obtain a refreshing, enlightening and meaningful camping experience. The Corporation's activities shall include but shall not be limited to general maintenance and improvement of the camp grounds and donations of new and renovated equipment and facilities to the camp; the rendering of guidance, aid and assistance to young people in order to permit them to experience the joy and delight of attending the camp; the fostering, developing and perpetuation of friendship and fellowship among former campers, staff members and those interested in promoting the welfare of the camp; and further, the engaging in other philanthropic activities incidental to or related to the purposes of the Corporation. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit
